Average attendance is 25-30 addicts and we have 2-4 newcomers each month.

We have two birthdays to announce Carol B. will celebrate 3 yrs on Nov. 27th and Ben E. will celebrate 11 yrs on Dec 18th. We have a lit order of \$38.40 and nothing for area for a total of \$38.40.

Hope Dealers – All is excellent with Hope Dealers. We have Sarah C. celebrating 1 year tomorrow at Hope Dealers. Come on out!

Keep it Green – Things are going well at Keep it Green. Average attendance is around 40 addicts per week and we had 2 newcomers this month. We are donating 6 basic texts to VRC this month.

Lunch Bunch – Attendance this month has been 415 recovering addicts with 16 newcomers.

Spiritual Awakenings – All is well at SA with a regular meeting attendance of 30-50 including at least 1 treatment center a week.

Step Write In – Average attendance is 40. I am starting service as GSR with this area.
