**OPEN FORUM TOPICS**

- 1.) A discussion ensued about the upcoming CAR and CAT reports. Things that were discussed:
  - \* Pricing of said reports. Answer: Our Area does not have to pay for it.
  - \* How many copies does our Area need? Answer: 24 copies
  - \* Should we get PDFs? Will PDFs be available? Answer: Yes, PDFs will be available
- 2.) The new Newsletter chair, David T., has requested ideas for the newsletter. An electronic version of the upcoming newsletter is being considered.
- 3.) Two members stated that the meeting list on the phone line is very out of date. Chris M. specifically noted that there were 24 incorrect listings. This was also mentioned at the last Regional meeting.

It was stated that that it's important that a minimum of two people know how to do everything necessary to manage and maintain the phone line. James R, the new elected PR chair has done research on the possibility of switching over service to a new company.

James called 60 different area phone lines. Many areas are using VoIP. 276-LIVE can be ported. Info about Freedom Voice (the company that PR is considering switching over to)

- 10 key press options (Sunday thru Monday) (one for males two for females)  
- unlimited time of recording
- We can port our 276-LIVE number for free
- \$8.96 a month plus tax 400 minutes of talk time
- \$22.46 a month plus tax for 1200 minutes
- Unlimited numbers of live addicts

- Can ring simultaneously to 15 numbers
- Unlimited number of “groups”
- No long term conditions (month to month basis)
- Virtual voice mail if no one answers (transcribed to email/text)
- Web portal log in
- No set up fee or up front charges
- 30 days free trial
- can pay through checking/routing number or mail in check

4.) An addict mentioned that both Positive Image and More Will Be Revealed have been closed when he visited there recently. There was a general feeling that these meetings should be removed from the meeting schedule if it is confirmed that they are no longer opening on a regular basis. Others at Area noted that they knew the people who open these meetings and will reach out to said people and then get back with WTASC with more info.

  - 1.) **Add Roman number X to the WTASC PUBLIC RELATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE GUIDELINES. Include the following under X:**

Meeting Schedule Coordinator and Backup responsibilities.

A. The Public Relations sub-committee is ultimately responsible for maintaining, updating, publishing and distributing meeting schedules for the West Tennessee Area of NA.

B. The meeting schedule format and processes should be approved by the PR subcommittee, not an individual. This includes all major changes, such as formatting.

C. The WTASC will fund all costs associated with the meeting schedules.

D. The meeting schedules should i. be published on a quarterly basis changing with the official starting months of the seasons: Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter and distributed at the March, June, September and December Area Service Committee meetings. ii. include meetings that have been occurring for at least 3 consecutive months.

E. At least two members of the PR sub-committee should know everything about the schedules; how to maintain them, how to update them, etc. One should be the Meeting Schedule Coordinator and the other is the Backup Meeting Schedule

Coordinator. This will ensure that if one member leaves the committee, the meeting schedules will continue production without interruption. Both positions will be voted on by the members of the PR Sub-Committee.

F. Meeting Schedule Coordinator should require one(1) year clean time and 3 months PR experience and should attend all PR Subcommittee meetings.

G. Actual work on the meeting schedules is carried out by a Meeting Schedule Coordinator (and Backup if necessary.)

H. The coordinator will respond in a timely manner to all inquiries or change requests and when necessary call upon PR Chair for assistance.

I. The Meeting Schedule Coordinator is responsible for i. gathering meeting details and maintaining that information for the committee. This includes whether meetings are still happening. ii. providing the PR Website Coordinator updated meeting schedule information as soon as possible. iii. for updating the NA.org meeting listings for the WTASCNA if a group is not maintaining their own meeting information. iv. distributing the meeting schedules at each Area Service Committee meeting. The number of schedules given out should be as follows: 1 bundle per individual H&I panel meeting and at least 1 bundle per meeting. Number of bundles may be more bundles based on meeting attendance and special needs. v. will make sure at least one other person, preferably the Alternate Meeting Schedule Coordinator and PR Chairperson, has a copy of all current files whenever changes are made.

J. Backup Meeting Schedule Coordinator should have the same requirements as Meeting Schedule Coordinator and their duties are to assist the Meeting Schedule Coordinator as needed.
