Regional Committee Member - There was much discussion about the idea of one group, one vote at Region. A number of years ago the region changed to that way of voting, rather than one area/one vote. There has been one group consistently who does not agree with voting that way so brings just one vote for the area rather than a tally of groups. It's been discussed multiple times and a motion made to change it back to one area/one vote. Finally it was decided that the area that refuses to follow along with the policy should be called out of order when they vote because they aren't

following the policy voted on by all the groups in the region. That area didn't vote at all this past VRSC. MWBR but maybe this was the end of this discussion for a while.

VRC update:

There were 101 pre, 156 regular registrations, 443 in newcomer donations

6000 seed money turned over and they are mailing remaining balance.

They counted 556 people at the Sat night meeting.

No 1 day registrations.

Speakers/workshops on vrc34.com website until February. (although they aren't there yet.)

There were 2 topics of discussion related to VRC. In Knoxville, on most years VRC rotates to that area, it falls on a big football weekend. They would like for the region to consider changing the rotation of areas. Chattanooga will ask their area if they are ok with switching with Knoxville in the rotation. Also, it was discussed that instead of just the VRC committee stand and be recognized, maybe the VRSC members could also be recognized at the Saturday night meeting. This will be deferred to the VRC guideline revision committee.

There was a letter read from Greater Nashville about non RCMs monopolizing the floor at region. It was very critical particularly of the admin body and there was much discussion. A copy of the letter and discussion points are in the regional minutes that are uploaded to natennessee.org/members.

Charmaine was voted in as PR chair and Eddie as H&I. They had both been voted in as interim before. What would you like to see these subcommittees do on a regional level?
