GROUP REPORTS

Good Orderly Direction – Hey you guys. Greetings from Good Orderly Direction. Attendance has been good this month. We averaged 33 to 40 addicts. However, we have no new members, no birthdays and no literature order this month.

Harmony – All is good at Harmony. We have 12-17 addicts in attendance and we had 2 newcomers this month.

High On Life – Greetings. All is well at and we still meet every Monday at 8:30 and all our topics are chosen out of the literature. We will be meeting on December 25th and January 1st as usual, so come on our and enjoy a great meeting after you enjoy the holidays with your bio family.

Hope Dealers – Greetings from Hope Dealers. All is good in the Arlington hood! We have an average meeting attendance of 10-50 addicts including newcomers.

Keep it Green – Things are going well at Keep it Green. We have an average of 55 addicts in attendance per week and had 1 newcomer this month.

Lunch Bunch – Lunch Bunch meets 7 days a week at noon except on Sundays at 2 pm. Saturdays are 90 minute meetings. We are a topic discussion meeting (one topic re JFT meditation and a topic from a passage in our literature). Tuesdays is a literature reading and discussion format. Attendance has been very good recently as we continue to offer an open and welcoming atmosphere often providing snacks. Newcomers and clients from treatment programs can always find support in our meetings.

One is Too Many – One is Too Many is doing well. We have an average of 15 people at each meeting. We have had no newcomers this month and no new members. We continue to have a speaker meeting on the last Friday of each month. This month Rex will be speaking.

Primary Purpose – All is well at Primary Purpose. We have an average attendance of 20-30 addicts. We had 5 newcomers last month. Primary Purpose will meet on the 24th (Christmas Eve) and the 31st (New Years Eve) – same time, same place.
